

Leadership Council Minutes

10/24/16

1. Mike Womack opened with prayer.
2. John Wortinger discussed the “DiscipleShift” book and shared his discipleship plan. This plan compels us to look at what it means to be a fully devoted disciple of Christ, the need we have to connect with Jesus and our fellow followers, the need to equip people to glorify God, and the need for intentional spiritual growth. This plan is applicable for all ages from children through adults.
3. John Wortinger discussed the need for a nursery coordinator.
 - The coordinator would coordinate children from 0-2 on Sundays and all ages for weekday church events.
 - Having a nursery coordinator would provide consistency.
 - The council agrees on the need to improve children’s ministries, but are unsure of the need for and the timing of the plan.
